This tool was later integrated in every EPIC (medical charting) platform in North America. She has won numerous awards for her work in human trafficking and has been featured in several media outlets including Johnson & Johnson and New York Magazine's "The Cut". Most recently, in July 2024, she published a 5-year analysis on this tool in Journal of Nursing Care Quality.

She continues to practice as an NP and serves as the System Director of Advanced Practice Education at Henry Ford Health.
